

EY Energy Alert / RFP Comments for \$1.2 BnUSD HVDC Transmission Line project in Mexico

Dear executive:

EY is pleased to release this Energy Alert providing a first analysis of the Tender specifications for the construction of a new high voltage direct current (HVDC) transmission line in South Mexico.

The ambitious timeline proposed by the counterpart, CFE (Comision Federal de Electricidad), includes a 10-day period for the Industry to share comments regarding the specifications such as payments in MXN, uncertainty on Right of Ways consecution, definition of local content, etc. Please send us an email at loic.legal@mx.ey.com with your concerns and/or a call request so we can consolidate suggestions to CFE before October 19th.

The transmission line will connect the Yautepec substation, situated 50 km away from the Mexico City substation, to the Ixtepec substation, situated approximately 30 km away from the Tehuantepec substation. The 1,260 km line requires two circuits, with a current rating of 3,000 MVA and a capacity of 3,000MW.
